What is your Chance at a Hole in One?

- Odds for an amateur: About 1 in 12,500 attempts.
- Odds for a professional: Roughly 1 in 2,500 attempts.
- Chance in any given round (amateur): Around 1 in 5,000.
- Chance in any given round (pro): About 1 in 1,000.
- Likelihood of two holes-in-one in the same round: Approximately 1 in 67 million.
- Odds of an albatross (ace on a par-4): Around 1 in 6 million.
- Percentage of golfers who will record an ace in their lifetime: Estimated at 1–2%.
- Most common hole length for an ace: Between 120–160 metres.

WHO AM I?

I'm an Australian golfer who dominated The Open Championship in a way no modern player has come close to matching. I won it five times, including three in a row during the 1950s — a streak so absurd that even today's stars shake their heads at it. My career stretched nearly four decades, and although I played before the world ranking era, many still argue I'm the most complete links player Australia has ever produced. I wasn't the longest hitter, nor the flashiest, but I was relentless: patient, precise, and annoyingly unflappable. While others tried to overpower courses, I simply out-thought them. My victories came in 1954, 1955, 1956, 1958 and 1965, cementing me as Australia's most prolific major champion. Who am I?
