Once the lightning cleared and conditions eased to light drizzle, many players headed back out to complete their rounds — a testament to the grit and good humour that define the club. A heartfelt thank you goes to Adrian Acheson from Thrive Advice for sponsoring the day's events, and to the many members and visitors who stayed back for presentations, capably MC'd by Captain Dan, despite the chaotic weather. Among the standout performers, Ben McIntosh set the tone early with a composed A Grade Stableford victory on countback the first of several achievements he would collect across the day. His superb form continued as he secured his second Monthly Medal in 12 months, reinforcing his reputation as one of Duntryleague's more consistent and composed competitors. He also recorded the low scratch score of the day a 75 an outstanding effort given the storm-affected conditions. It was also a brilliant afternoon for Luke Pearman, who not only claimed the B Grade Stableford title but backed it up with 2nd place in the C Grade Monthly Medal, a rare and impressive double across two formats, showcasing his versatility and resilience. The day's elite pin-seeker was unquestionably Ben Williams, who claimed two NTPs and delivered a 50 cm dart on the 7th to secure the Pro Pin. In swirling winds and post-storm drizzle, his precision was nothing short of exceptional. Despite the weather's best attempts to derail the day, the competition produced outstanding golf, memorable moments, and a clubhouse full of good spirits, everything that makes Duntryleague special.
